I know that there has been much discussion regarding possible school closures and we do not have any more information than you. However, in anticipation of closure, when and if it happens we will be sending home all home learning packs on Friday. We are continuously updating the home learning page with activities and ideas for learning opportunities at home.

I am sure that you will join me in thanking our amazing staff who are coming to school each day, many of whom have vulnerable relatives and friends. We do not have the choice to work from home.
