We were fortunate this week to receive a grant of £550 from Edufund to purchase the last remaining resources for our Forest School which will definitely be up and running in September.

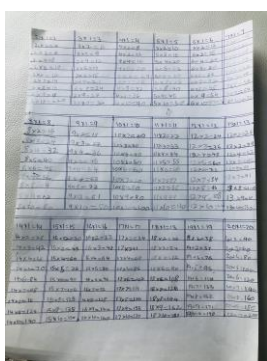
