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Dear Parents,

When we closed the school on the 20th March to all but our key worker children I always thought that we would fully return before the Summer break but sadly this is not to be.

Over the last few weeks there has been a great deal of guidance and speculation to contend with however, we now have a plan to extend our opening but unfortunately only to certain year groups. There is still so much scientific uncertainty and concern for vulnerable members of your family's and I know that this has factored in the decision of many of you not to send your children back to school before July 17th. I would like to re-iterate that in terms of attendance you will not be penalised for this and I fully appreciate your concerns.

For those children who are returning to school it will be different; we will try to make it as fun as possible for the next 7 weeks.

I believe that our school is unique with it's warm, friendly and caring culture and this will continue but we do wish that we were all back together.

So what does this mean for everybody until July 17th?

Wider re-opening

For those of you that wish you child to return you will have received your letters.

Please read them carefully. There are lots of instructions on how we are staggering start and end times, which entrances to use etc. and of course keeping a safe distance.

It important that you follow these in order to help us keep everyone safe.

If you change your mind and want to send your child in you MUST give us at least 1 weeks' notice. We have a number of staff absent and I will need to amend rotas and to check that we have adequate space. Similarly for Year 1 who are on a Week A/ Week B timetable please only bring your child to school on their designated week.

- Oak Class are in Oak Class Group Week B June 8th







All teachers have been briefed on the safety measures being put in place.

All support staff are taking part in virtual meetings today to ask questions and so that I can address concerns.

We are aware that many of you will have some reading scheme and library books at home. We would very much appreciate it if you would return these; a plastic box will be outside the main







entrance for you to pop them in and we will spray them with antibacterial spray before children in school use them. We cannot afford to replace such a huge number of books for the year ahead. I would really appreciate your help with this.
